**Eligibility:** To be eligible for scholarship funds, the applicant must:

- Be an Eastern High School graduate, graduating in the academic year of the application.
- Have a 2.5 cumulative grade point average or higher.
- Plan to attend a college, university, or technical school in the following school year.

**Directions:**

- Complete the general application for this scholarship.
- Complete the essay (300 words or less).
- Attach a copy of your transcript and two letters of recommendation from non-family members.

**Application Procedure:**

1. Application forms are available at your guidance office.
2. Application must be postmarked **no later than the 3rd Saturday in April.**

**Selection Procedure:**

The Scholarship Committee will select the recipient(s). The scholarship will be awarded based on the information contained in the application form. Consideration will be given to the following:

- Academic Performance
- School and/or community involvement
- Written communication skills

**Award Notification:**

The winner(s) of the Blevins Wolfhound Memorial Scholarship will be notified **by the 2nd Monday in May.**

**Disbursements:**

At the scholarship committee's discretion, the scholarship award will be sent directly to the student. To request a payment of the award, the awardee must present evidence of enrollment at the designated institution. The student must also send a receipt to the committee illustrating how the dollars were used.
