The Brown/Clermont County Farmers Union established the Joseph C. Glover Memorial Scholarship fund with the Brown County Foundation on 10/23/2015, to recognize and remember Joseph C. Glover who worked very diligently to begin the Brown County Farmers Union Organization which has worked for the family farmer, and to encourage post-secondary education/training in the agricultural field for Brown County Youth.

The Joseph C. Glover Memorial Scholarship award is open to any high school senior who has been accepted to an accredited institution of higher learning intending to major in the field of agriculture. The institution of higher learning is not limited to a 4-year college. Two scholarships of \$500.00 each will be awarded to qualified students in May of this year and paid directly to the student's institution of higher learning upon the Brown County Foundation's receipt of a copy of the student's tuition bill or other proof of enrollment.

Applicants will need to complete an application which will be scored on the basis of scholastic achievement, career goals, leadership activities, good character, participation in youth organizations, and school activities. Financial need is not required, but it may be considered. A personal interview may also be requested. A one page (8 1/2" x 11") may be added to summarize your accomplishments and goals. One letter of recommendation may also be included.
