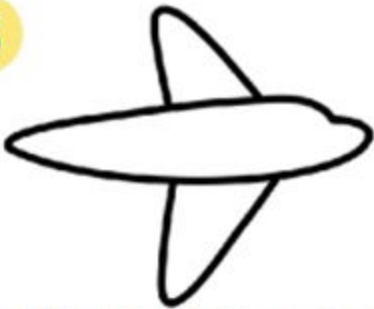
Just below the center of the paper, draw a long curved line. It looks like a wide smile.

2



On one side, draw a bump for the nose of the plane. Draw a curved line back towards the tail of the plane.

3



On each side of the plane, draw the wings. The front of the wing angles back, while the back of the wings are straight out from the plane.

4



Add two curved lines to the back of the plane to create the tail.

5



Add a windshield and windows.

6



Add additional details such as stripes or a logo.

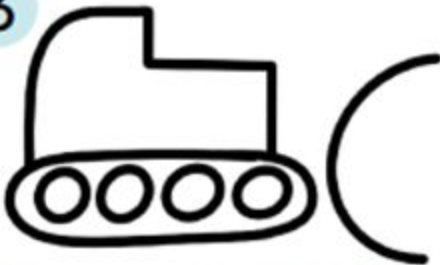
Draw or trace wheels near the bottom of your paper. Keep the wheels on the left side so that you have room for your blade on the right. Draw a flat oval around the wheels.

2



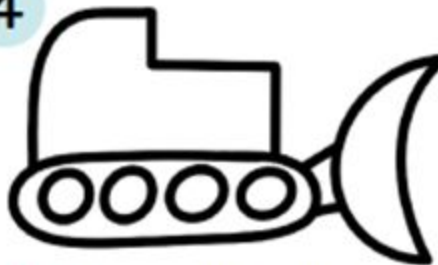
Add a curved line up from the back of the wheels that ends near the top of your paper above the middle of the wheels. Draw a step-like line down to the front of the wheels.

3



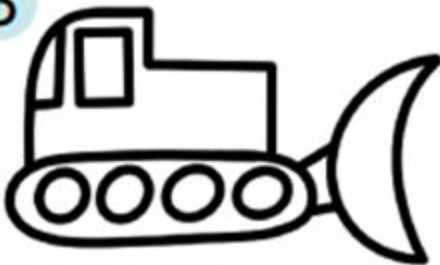
Add a large "C" shape in front of the bulldozer for the blade.

4



Add another "C" shape inside the blade to connect the ends. Add lines to connect the blade to the bulldozer.

5



Add windows to the bulldozer.

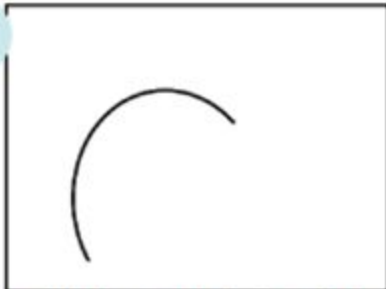
6



Add extra details to your bulldozer, such as an exhaust pipe, engine vent lines, hubcaps, etc.

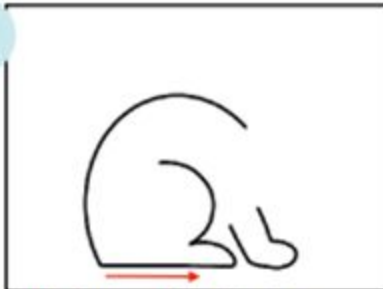
BULLDOZER DRAWING GUIDE

The rabbit begins with drawing its back. Draw a large letter "C" that is angled.

2



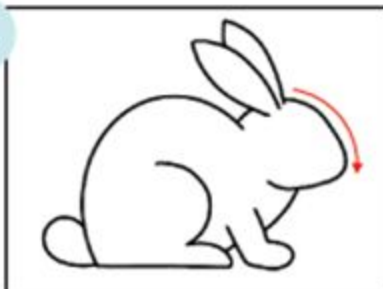
From the bottom of the "C", draw a horizontal line that ends with the back foot. Draw a backwards "C" for the leg. Add a front leg.

3



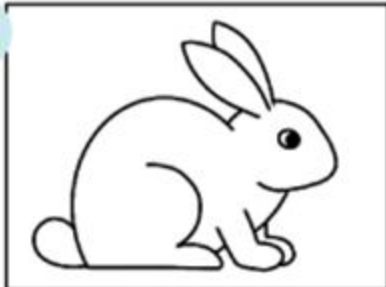
Draw an ear. Add a curved line behind the front foot for the rabbit's chest. Add a tail.

4



Add another ear behind the first ear. Draw the rabbit's head. It looks like a backwards "C."

5



Add an eye. Draw the second front leg behind the first front leg.

6



Add a nose, mouth, inner-ear and lines on the paws.
