

SPC Seth Blevins Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility: To be eligible for scholarship funds, the applicant must:

- Be a Brown County graduate, graduating in the academic year of the application.
- Have an active service or veteran family member including: father, mother, sibling, grandparent, or great-grandparent.
- Have a 2.5 cumulative grade point average or higher.
- Plan to attend a college, university, or technical school in the following school year.

Directions:

- Complete the general application for this scholarship. **Please do not staple the scholarship packet.**
- Complete the essay (300 words or less).
- Attach a copy of your transcript, two letters of recommendation from non-family members, and documentation of the active or veteran status of a father, mother, sibling, or grandparent. You can contact the local Veterans Office for documentation if needed.

Application Procedure:

1. Application forms are available at your guidance office.
2. Application must be postmarked **no later than the 3rd Saturday in March.**

Selection Procedure:

The Scholarship Committee will select the recipient(s). The scholarship will be awarded based on the information contained in the application form. Consideration will be given to the following:

- Academic Performance
- School and/or community involvement
- Written communication skills

Award Notification:

The winner(s) of the Seth Blevins Memorial Scholarship will be notified **by the 1st Monday in May.**

Disbursements:

At the scholarship committee's discretion, the scholarship award will be sent directly to the student. To request a payment of the award, the awardee must present evidence of enrollment at the designated institution. The student must also send a receipt to the committee illustrating how the dollars were used.
