Memo of Understanding

Eastern's W.A.V.E. (Schools PLP) is an alternative way to receive an education. The instruction is given exclusively online and all assignments are completed and submitted online as well. Progress is monitored by Eastern personnel; however, the grading is all done electronically and there is no guarantee that assistance will be given by a certified/licensed teacher. EHS is a four-year institution. The W.A.V.E. is not designed for students to get ahead.

To be successful on the W.A.V.E. program self-discipline is required. Students have access to the program 24/7 from virtually anywhere. ELSD does not provide computers to students. Parents/Guardians are responsible for providing computers and any updates needed to allow their student access to the online coursework. In the event that a computer fails, parents/guardians must ensure their student continues working at a library or place of their choice until the computer issue is resolved. Attendance, of course, is not taken in a traditional way; however, progress will be checked and students are expected to be completing an adequate number of lessons (specified in their individual contract) or else action will be taken. Actions may include, but are not limited to: ineligibility, truancy charges, unruly charges, mandatory on campus attendance or regularly scheduled meetings, removal from the program.

W.A.V.E. students are Eastern students. Students are permitted to attend any school events, join school clubs, and participate in extracurricular activities. Students are subject to the Ineligibility list based on their grade average and completion of the appropriate lessons. W.A.V.E. students must abide by the Eastern Student Handbook. To meet the eligibility requirements of the Ohio High School Athletic Association, students must be actively enrolled and passing 5 classes.

In the event a student encounters technical issues or fails a lesson and needs assistance or a student/guardian has questions regarding the W.A.V.E., they should contact the W.A.V.E. Coordinator, Rochelle Kelch or Assistant Coordinator Meg Anderson. Mrs. Kelch is a teacher for Eastern Local Schools and may not be able to answer calls/emails during the school day, but will return calls/emails as soon as possible after the school day has ended. Mrs. Anderson will be available via email throughout the school day. Rules/Guidelines

- 1. Required advisory meeting with counselor, student and parent/guardian.
- 2. Classes are assigned and chosen by counselor/principal.
- 3. School fees are still mandatory to graduate from EHS.
- 4. Once a student starts the online program, he or she will adhere to the same "drop/add" policy as the Eastern "brick and mortar" students.
- 5. If a student wishes to return to school after attempting the online program, the student must wait until the next semester to begin traditional schooling, or file an appeal with the WAVE committee.
- 6. A Memo of Understanding must be signed by parent, student and counselor.
- 7. Any student choosing the full-time (online) W.A.V.E. model who is currently receiving special education services or 504 accommodations will be required to hold a team meeting to discuss change of placement. A student with a disability will be required to meet with an intervention specialist weekly for specially designed instruction. Google Hangouts, email, on-campus time, or a combination of each will be used.

- 8. Any student (grades 9-12) choosing the full-time W.A.V.E. model waives the right to special awards and recognition given by the school (ex. Valedictorian, four years perfect attendance, National Honor Society, Honors Diploma).
- 9. Students are to be showing adequate progress as determined by the W.A.V.E coordinator.
- 10. If students are not making adequate progress as specified in their contract it may result in disciplinary action, as outlined on page 1.
- 11. All coursework must be completed by the last day of the school year for underclassmen and May 1st for seniors.
- 12. W.A.V.E. students will be required to take all state-mandated tests and district assessments in order to meet all district and state requirements for graduation.


For Credit Recovery Students:

W.A.V.E. serves as an opportunity for students to make up or recover credits. Students may take as many classes as needed. Students will be required to retake courses they have failed in regular classes if they received less than a "2" on the End of Course Exam for that subject.

2. Proceed to Links, locate and click on the SchoolsPLP (WAVE plus) link.






5. Each course consists of Units that contain lessons, quizzes, practice tests and a final test for each unit.






6. When finished working or need to leave the program always return to your student page using the link located under the course name.
