Students will receive a student progress book login and password during their social studies class.



Homework

Students are expected to read 20 minutes outside of class each day.

Students will have homework in math Monday through Thursday.

Homework may be assigned in any class on any day. This includes studying for tests/quizzes.

Be advised, homework assignments may be collected and graded at any time.

Student Accountability

All students are expected to complete the assigned homework and classwork.

Late work will receive partial credit.

Students who do not complete assignments may be assigned to a lunch detention, Friday School, or Alternative School.

***Reminds will be sent daily as a courtesy. However, it is the responsibility of the students to write down daily homework.

Attendance Policy

Work assigned prior to an absence is due the day a student returns to school. Students are responsible for collecting all work missed upon returning to class. Any parent/guardian that chooses to pick up work when their child is absent will need to contact the office by 9 am or work may not be ready until the following day.

Dress Code

Students are expected to dress in a modest fashion. Shorts and dresses must be no shorter than mid-thigh. Undergarments are to be covered at all times.

Cell Phone Usage

Students are permitted to use cell phones while in the cafeteria during breakfast and lunch time. Cell phones will remain in student lockers when not in use.

All correspondence, during school hours, should take place through the office.
